

As Geographers we will be:
using geographical vocabulary to describe the similarities and differences between our local area and East Park. We will continue to explore weather and will identify the differences between winter and spring.

As Historians we will be:
comparing games and parks from a long time ago to now. We will be looking at how they have changed, and why, using historical language to explain our reasoning.

In Maths we will be:

As Musicians we will be:

composing a short piece of music, using a range of percussion instruments. We will record our composition on a simple graphic score.

In Computing we will be:

exploring algorithms through creating a multi-step algorithm for a programmable toy. We will also explore how to keep personal information private online.

In Religion and World Views we will be:

learning how to care for our world. We will also look at the Christian customs associated with Easter.

In PE we will be:

Perform a dance including different shapes, a jump and turn. We will also work on our ball skills by practising our passing, throwing and catching.

In English we will be:

beginning with 'Percy the Park Keeper' by Nick Butterworth - a conquering the monster story. We will then move onto our non-narrative, writing an explanation text on why hedgehogs are difficult to find.

As Scientists we will be:

exploring different types of animals and classifying them by what they eat. We will continue to explore the seasonal changes, particularly thinking about changes that happen in winter.

As Artists we will be:

exploring the work of Van Gogh and using his artwork as a stimulus to create our own. We will be developing our drawing skills to create our own still life drawing of flowers.

As Design Technologists we will be:

making a strong and sturdy structure in the form of a swing for Percy's playground.
