As Artists we will be:

As Historians we will be:

As Musicians we will be:

following a simple score to help us to play instruments at the correct time.



In PE we will be:

learning how to perform a log roll, stretch jump and three second balance in gymnastics. In games, we will be learning how to throw, catch and kick a ball accurately.

In English we will be:

beginning with a rags to riches story inspired by the text 'The Story of Pirate Tom'. We will then move onto our non-narrative unit writing instructions on how to get ready for playtime.

As Design Technologists we will be:

creating a healthy fruit snack for 'Pirate Tom' to take on his long journey across the seven seas. We will be exploring the skills of chopping, peeling and grating.

As Scientists we will be:

exploring a range of everyday materials and sorting them in a variety of different ways. We will be using our observational skills to note seasonal changes.

In Religion and World Views we will be:

exploring artefacts that belong to a Christian faith and a Jewish faith. We will also learn the Nativity Story and its importance to Christians.

In Computing we will be:

exploring the technology which can be found in the home. We will also begin to explore personal information and the importance of keeping this private online.

In Maths we will be:

beginning with a review of place value to 10, alongside exploring number bonds to improve our rapid recall, before moving onto addition and subtraction.
