In Spanish, we will build on our knowledge of introducing people by using some newly learned phrases. We will also learn nouns related to the classroom.

As geographers we will be comparing and contrasting Britain and Denmark. We will understand what settlements are, why Anglo-Saxons chose Britain and how they have shaped Britain today.

As computer scientists we will be using the hardware 'Micro:bit' to program algorithms which include an if and then statement.

As scientists we will be investigating the properties of a range of materials whilst learning how different processes can be used to change a material. We will also explore how some of these changes can be reversed and some cannot.

In religion and worldview we will be learning how people from different walks of life and faiths express their beliefs.

As artists we will be analysing the works of Vincent Van Gogh and Paul Cezanne as a stimulus to then create our own still life drawings.

As historians we will be learning about why Anglo-Saxons invaded and settled in England, and how this impacted on law and order.

As design and technologists we will make a plant-based burger, using a given design criteria, selecting sustainable ingredients and considering accurate measurements.

As musicians we will be using crotchets and quavers to create a simple composition on a stave.

In maths, we will start the term by consolidating and developing our understanding of place value and then we will move on to learning formal methods for addition and subtraction.

In reading, we will take a look at many amazing texts including Novels, picture books & poems. You can see a selection of the texts on this page.

In writing, we will be learning the features of a conquering the monster story and then writing our own innovated story, based on 'Beowulf'.
