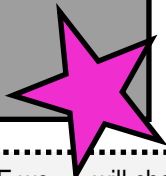
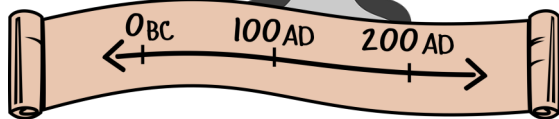


What's on in KP/LH and GS Autumn Term 2024



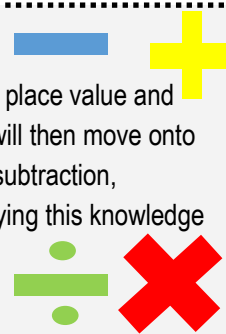
In PSHE, we will explain how behaviour can affect others and that it is important to have rules. We will also look into how to resolve conflicts with family and friendship groups.



As historians, we will describe the characteristic features of the Stone-Age, Bronze-Age and Iron-Age and give some reasons for the changes from the Stone-Age to the Iron-Age. We will learn about how life changed once people in the later Stone-Age began to settle in one place and what this meant for people living in the immediate historical periods following this.



In maths, we will begin by looking at place value and exploring numbers up to 1000. We will then move onto using the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division) and applying this knowledge by solving problems.

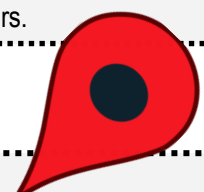


In PE we will choreograph and perform a gymnastics routine that contains a forward roll to standing, a stretch jump, a tuck jump and a star jump, a side balance for a minimum of 3 seconds and a move holding own body weight with hands on the floor and feet off the floor. We will also be learning to pass a large ball accurately, using our hands and feet to dribble.

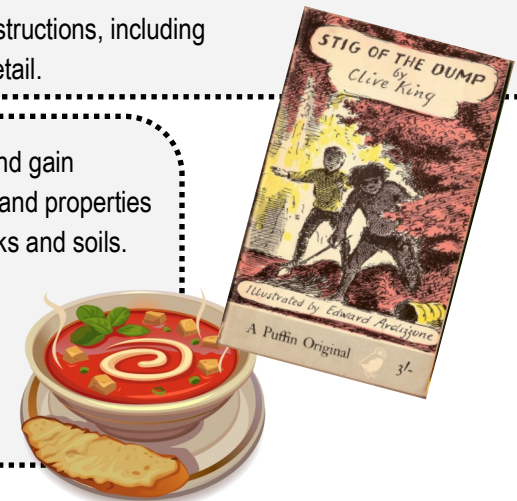
In music, we will compose and perform a group piece of music in response to a given stimulus, recording ideas on a simple score using a combination of standard (crochets and quavers) and non-standard



As geographers, we will identify and draw conclusions about why and how settlements grew around Hull and Creswell, comparing and contrasting the facilities in each. We will be looking at different types of maps, including Ordnance Survey maps and identifying what the symbols mean.



As scientists, we will investigate and gain knowledge about the appearance and properties of a range of different types of rocks and soils. We will then plan a scientific enquiry to compare the physical properties of a range of rocks soils and draw conclusions.



In autumn 1, we will be writing our own finding tales, using 'Stone Age Boy' as inspiration. We will then be using these stories to write a newspaper report.

In autumn 2, we will be writing a warning story, taking inspiration from 'Stig of the Dump'. Our non-narrative text will be to write a set of clear instructions, including more detail.

In D&T we will be using seasonal ingredients that complement each other to make a healthy soup. We will need to use seasonal vegetables and incorporate these into a design.
